On the following pages you will find our first desktop rally for 2009. This page has an explanation and a list of reference point and the rally proper is on the following pages. The reference points are used so the rally can be marked remotely by me.

The event has been set at Masters level but remember there is not the pressure of time, the kitchen table is not bouncing around and you do not have a driver want to know which way to turn at this TJ that is coming up. Take it one step at a time, remember the standard rally rules and note the information in the "Notes" in the heading etc. I would suggest that you plot the reference points first and then, as you plot the rally, each time you come across a reference point write down that reference point letter including your direction of entry and exit at that point.

Once you have finished, email to me the list of reference point as you came across them, remembering to include the direction of entry and exit to each point. When emailing your reply, please use the email address for the pointscorer in the magazine.

Reference points of CRC Desktop Rally, March 2009.

Below are listed an assortment of reference points. Some points are on the rally route, some are not. Some may be visited more than once. For your answer, list the reference points in the order you come across them on the route. If you pass through a point more than once then list the point again. In your answer you must show your direction of entry and exit against each of the points visited.

e.g. C- Entry from N, Exit to W;
K- Entry from SSW, Exit to ENE;
C- Entry from S, Exit to W etc.

Notes- National Route markers, tracks and the South Western Motorway are out of bounds. The motorway may be crossed. An instruct to leave a feature on your left or right means passing within 1 km of that feature on the stated side. A via point may be visited again without being specified again, but only after visiting it as specified in the route instructions. Do not oppose rally traffic in this event.

		Via	Cross a bridge.
		Via	RJ nearest Miranda Rail Station. Leave Loftus Rail station on your left.
		Via	Rail crossing at GR 32152447. Leave Olympic Park on your right.
		Via	An unmapped road that starts at a kink in a Secondary road at GR 31682428, passes over the South Western Motorway and joins a Minor road immediately S of the start point.
		Via	Cross a bridge.
		Via	XR on State route 31 where a Principal road, a Secondary road and a Minor road meet.
		Via	RJ at GR 30812421. Enter from ESE. Do a full loop inside an Airport.
		Via	Four way intersection at GR 30602395.
		Via	RJ on a line drawn between Willoughby and Leumeah Rail Stations and 8 kms from Leumeah Rail Station after having travelled beside a railway for 2 kms.

Division 1 Section 1 (cont)

- Via RJ 56mm from Engadine rail station and 39kms from Blaxland Rail Station.
- Via RJ at GR 30302342 after having crossed a Powerline twice while S of 34⁰.
- Via A Locality.
- Via Cross a Railway while on a Minor road.
- M2 A Locality after having used some unsealed road.
