



## DAVE JOHNSON AUTUMN CLASSIC

- Start :** MacDonalds Restaurant at Sutton Forest, NSW. **Southbound**  
Cnr. Of Hume Highway and Sallys Corner Road.  
Registration from 7 to 8 AM, Briefing 8.30 AM Start 9 AM
- Finish:** Moss Vale Services Club, Illawarra Highway Moss Vale.  
First Due at abt 4.30 PM
- Lunch:** Crookwell Public School. Approx. 11.45am to 1 pm

It will be run as the first of the new Navigation Assemblies, established under the National Touring Code, with two Divisions of about 180 and 200 kms each.

There will be a time set for each Division as allowed under the new National Touring Code. This is really to enable us to officially close the lunch control but it will mean that there will be a penalty for late arrival there.

As with the former NSW Provisional Touring Code there are some NSW centric rules that have been added and you should look at the composite document that Mike Batten and Dave Johnson have compiled to give you the best reading of the final rules for that apply for NAs in NSW

There will be 4 Categories of competition.

**Masters** will be as normal with 25 kms of good dirt and gravel roads in Division 1 and 8kms in Division 2. The CRC protocol of having a VRC board or question within the first km of unsealed road will be observed.

**Apprentices** will have the same course as the Masters and some extra information to take away some of the pain that they encounter.

Masters and Apprentices will be using old maps. Bring your normal ruler/scale to read kms on a 1:250k map and a normal cm ruler to let you measure from a 1:100k map. A Rally Roamer for use on the imperial gridded maps will be provided for you to check the locations plotted for you on the maps. Most locations will be plotted for you.

**Tour,** will have 780 metres of gravel in its entire length. Fully Route Charted.
